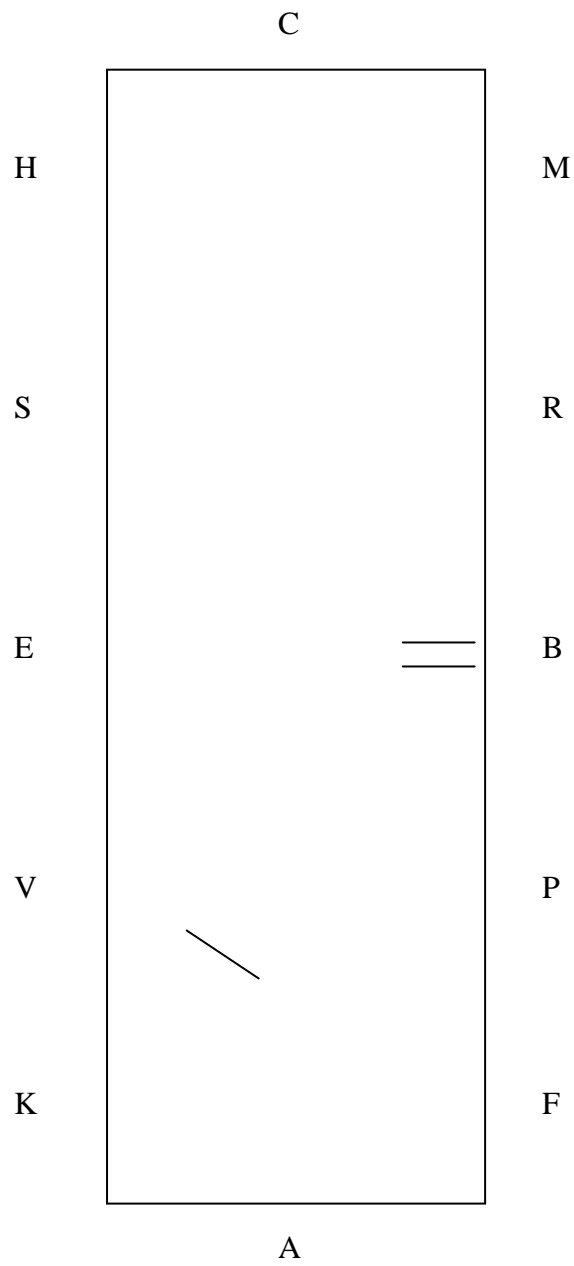

The test will be judged in a similar fashion to Hunter Equitation Classes.

Rider must maintain a balanced position throughout. The horse/pony should maintain an even rhythm, accepting the bit & jump fence calmly.

All trot work is optional rising or sitting

The fence at B is fence 1, 2, 3, 4 (oxer)

The fence on the diagonal KXM is fence 5 (vertical)

Maximum fence height 60cm for Prelim, for each progressive level, the bar will be raised one extra level

Dressage or all purpose saddles are to be used. No jumping saddles permitted.

ASA jumping helmets must be worn

Jumping whip, spurs, breastplate, bandages, boots may be used

Martingales, dressage whips may not be used

Riders are expected to shorten their stirrup length

Body protectors are optional
